GALINA U. SKORLUPKINA, Clinical psychologist of the State budget institution "City psycho-neurological care home", Nizhny Novgorod region, expert of the All-Russian Federation of PID Sports team, certified referee on sports of people with intellectual disabilities. developed communication skills, with a low and a high emotional sensitivity, for younger insecure clients.



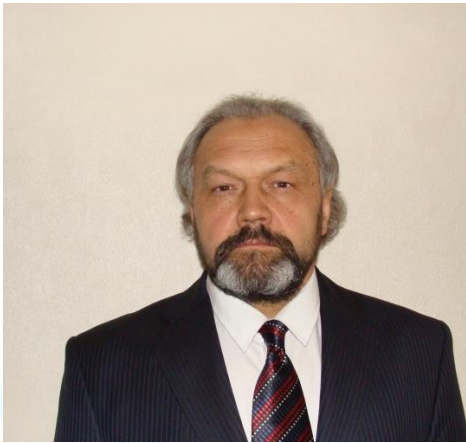
